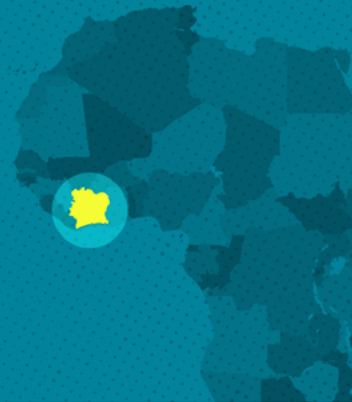

OUR STORY

Karina attended SAGU where she got her BA in Intercultural Studies and her love for Africa and heart for Muslims grew. Antonio attended a vocational school and earned his degree as an electrician.

While Karina spent a semester in Ivory Coast, God spoke to both of us on how he can use us to fulfill the calling he has placed in our lives. In 2017, we got married and now have a family. In 2023, we came out to the mission field as a family for the first time. Since being here God has been speaking to us and giving us a vision for our ministry.

OUR MINISTRY

While attending Base Camp, we have learned language (French), culture, and how to effectively minister to the people of Ivory Coast. We have heard God speak, give direction and vision for our next term as missionaries. Our vision is to see a healthy church amongst the Lebanese people here in Côte d'Ivoire.

The Lebanese people are majority Muslim and have been notoriously difficult to reach. For years the Lebanese have immigrated across West Africa including in Ivory Coast. There are currently over 100,000 Lebanese in Ivory Coast. AGWM has a vision to see the Lebanese reached across West Africa and have launched an initiative called the Abidjan Project. This initiative will focus on bringing the Gospel to the Lebanese of Ivory Coast.

About Us

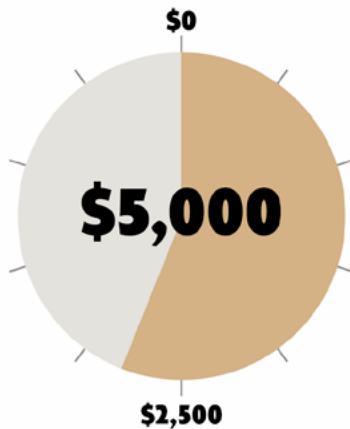

ABOUT OUR MINISTRY

Military members sacrificially serve away from home for long periods of time. They face loneliness, depression, marital problems, and more. The remote area of Misawa coupled with the dark, cold, and isolating winters exasperates their difficult living situation. We know Jesus is the only hope and can bring freedom and healing through salvation. While we have a brief time with those stationed in Misawa, we believe God gave us a strategic plan for ministry. He stated in Colossians 1:28,

"He is the one we proclaim, admonishing and teaching everyone with all wisdom, so that we may present everyone fully mature in Christ."

Our desire at Neighborhood is to fulfill this vision. We seek to provide a place of growth through Bible studies, discipleship, evangelism, missions, worship, prayer, serving, and fellowship. Our goal is to see each member mature in Christ and then send them out to serve Him around the world.

ABOUT OUR FAMILY

Wilman and Liz have over 20 years of ministerial experience. In 2011, they felt God calling them to missions, specifically reaching the military community stationed overseas. Wilman's experience serving in the United States Army provides a unique understanding of the hardships, difficulties, and spiritual challenges military members face. Kudjip Nazarene Hospital has been a vital ministry of the Church of the Nazarene since 1967. Along with over 300 staff members from across PNG, we also minister alongside about 20 missionary families who fill essential roles such as doctors, teachers, administrators, IT specialists, church developers and maintenance project managers.

At Kudjip Nazarene Hospital we are passionate about caring for the whole person—striving to meet the physical, emotional and spiritual needs of each patient who enters our gates. Each year we care for over 50,000 outpatients and 10,000 inpatients. Our staff deliver over 3,000 babies and perform about 1,500 major surgeries every year. We are excited to be teaching and training Papua New Guinean medical students and residents. Through this effort we have the valuable opportunity to empower the next generation of PNG physicians by modeling Christ-like, compassionate care for all people.



OUR CALLING

For the past 16 years, we have served as senior pastors of Neighborhood Church Okinawa. Our mission is simple yet urgent: to connect people to Jesus and to one another. We shepherd souls toward healing, disciple believers, and create spaces for community to flourish.



Our ministry is uniquely positioned to reach two groups:

- The American military stationed overseas – men and women who carry the weight of deployment, separation, and the struggles of military family life.
- The international community of Okinawa – people from every nation in need of the gospel, fellowship, and healing.

Church Planting in
German-Speaking Europe



About Me

I just returned from a 3 year MA term in German-Speaking Europe where I was a part of a Church Planting Team with Mike and Laura Clark. We currently have 2 Church plants in Bregenz, Austria and Vaduz, Liechtenstein. The Church plant in Liechtenstein is the first ever Evangelical church in this small country of 30,000 people. During my term I helped with both of these church plants with a focus on pioneering a youth group in Bregenz, Austria. I planted the youth group in Austria in June of 2021, which started out with 2 young girls and has grown into a youth group that meets every week with around 8 students. I also led the Kids Ministry, was a part of the preaching team once a month, and focused on learning the language. The church plant in Liechtenstein was planted about 2 years ago and they currently meet once every other week with about 20 people in attendance. I was able to be a part of this Church plant initiative from the beginning and learned about what it takes to plant a church and to partner with the locals so that we can reach the locals. It was a great first term and I cannot wait to get back to reach more people.

When I return to the field, I will be focusing more on reaching youth and young adults in the area. Less than one percent of the population in German-Speaking Europe are born again believers with 20% being between the ages of 18-35. That is why I am called to go back to German-Speaking Europe in order for more young people to have access to the Gospel and to be able to accept Jesus as their savior.

I hope to be fully funded by January of 2025.
